BASIC INFORMATION

The International Expert-Conference on the Human Rights of older Persons 2023, organized by the Federal Ministry of Social Affairs, Health, Care and Consumer Protection, will take place in Vienna from 29 November - 01 December 2023. There will be translation for German and English.

VENUE

The Conference will take place at the Libelle on top of the Leopold Museum (MuseumsQuartier - Museumsplatz 1/5, 1070 Wien).

The conference venue lies within walking distance from **Hotel Regina** (1.5 km) and **NH Wien City** (500 m). Additionally, we offer a **bus** from and to Hotel Regina. For either kind of transportation, we will meet in each **hotel's lobby**:

REGISTRATION

ACCREDITATION AND ACCESS

Participants will receive their accreditation infomation and QR-Code to obtain their conference-badges from liaison officers at the welcome reception at the "Ovalhalle" on November 29 from **5.30 to 6 pm**. It is also possible to accredit on the first conference day on November 30 from **9 to 9.20** am, at the "Libelle".

ACCOMMODATION

You are kindly asked to book and pay for your accommodation yourself.

Booking and hotel costs (meaning accommodation and breakfast, excluding additional expenses such as minibar) for panelists, moderators, and keynote speakers are covered by the Federal Ministry.

The Federal Ministry has made a preliminary reservation at **Hotel Regina**. Due to the high number of participants, this allocation is now only available from **30 November to 01 December 2023**. We are currently in contact with other hotels, working to find a solution.

TRANSPORTATION

You are kindly asked to organize your own transport to and from Vienna.

The city center is located 20 km from Vienna International Airport and is easily accessible by public transport.

a) Train Connections

The Austrian Federal Railways (ÖBB) offers a Railjet service that connects Vienna Airport with Vienna Hauptbahnhof (main train station) in approximately 15 minutes. There are also direct connections to the city center with the S 7 rapid transit railway.

b) Airport Shuttle Service

The City Airport Train (CAT) offers a direct non-stop connection between Vienna Airport and the city center in 16 minutes (Wien Mitte train station – Bahnhof Wien Mitte).

c) Vienna Airport Lines

The Vienna Airport Line offers a direct bus service to various destinations in the city center.

d) Taxis

There is a taxi stand opposite the arrival hall's exit at the airport. A taxi ride from the airport to Vienna city center typically costs between EUR 40 and EUR 50.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Vienna has a fully integrated public transport network. The underground, trams and buses run every day from approximately 5:00 a.m. until just after midnight. On Fridays and Saturdays the underground runs all through the night. For environmental reasons we suggest to use public transport whenever possible.

LUNCH & DINNER

On both conference days, lunch will be served at the conference venue – MQ Libelle.

On 30 November the Ministry is delighted to offer you a dinner at a famous "Heurigen" **Mayer am Pfarrplatz** with traditional food and beverages.

The tradition-steeped Mayer am Pfarrplatz winery has been producing the best Viennese wines since 1683 in Heiligenstadt. In 1817, Ludwig van Beethoven lived in the romantic listed suburban home on Pfarrplatz and worked on his greatest creation, Symphony No. 9.

We are happy to offer a shuttle service from **Hotel Regina** and **NH Wien City** to the Heurigen. Meeting point in each hotel's lobby will be **6.30 pm**. The shuttle will return to the city centre at around **10 pm**.

Austria uses Central European Time (CET), which is UTC plus 1 hour.
